Announcement of Synchrotron Light Research Institute (Public Organization)
Preventive Measures and Surveillances of Coronavirus (2019-nCoV)
(No.11)

Regarding the current outbreak of Coronavirus (COVID-19) with more cases reported in many provinces in Thailand and worldwide, to sustain performing under related measures and prevent possible effects on health of SLRI colleagues working in the area, additional preventive measures and surveillances of COVID-19 are required.

Pursuant to the Decree of Board of SLRI, Ref. No. 7/2020, on “Appointment of Chief Executive Officer of Synchrotron Light Research Institute” issued on 29 May 2020, SLRI hereby issues the Announcement of Synchrotron Light Research Institute (Public Organization) on Preventive Measures and Surveillances of Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) (No.11) as follows:

1. SLRI colleagues and visitors are required to enter and leave SLRI area only at the main entrance at Wing A, 1st floor, Sirindhorn Witchothai Building and are required to have temperature check and shoes sanitized before entering SLRI area.
2. Hygienic alcohol for sanitation is provided in the area.
3. Appropriate personal protective equipment for COVID-19 such as hand gloves, surgical masks, face shields, etc. are provided.
4. Seats in SLRI canteen are arranged under appropriate measures.
5. Floor markings in elevators are provided under appropriate measures.
6. High-touched surfaces are frequently cleaned.
7. Work-contact with other people is permitted only at provided area.

8. Closed bins for dispose of used hand gloves, surgical masks, and face shields are provided under appropriate measures.

9. Clause 3 stated in the Announcement of Synchrotron Light Research Institute (Public Organization) on Guidelines for Prevention Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) (No.5) and Clause 6 stated in the Announcement of Synchrotron Light Research Institute (Public Organization) on Guidelines for Prevention Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) (No.10) are repealed and the following Clause shall be enforced instead:

“SLRI colleagues and visitors are required to always wear surgical masks whenever entering SLRI area.”

10. Clause 2 stated in the Announcement of Synchrotron Light Research Institute (Public Organization) on Guidelines for Prevention Measure and Surveillance of Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) (No.9) is repealed and the following Clause shall be enforced instead:

“SLRI services with physical presence of users shall be provided only to domestic ones except for those coming from COVID-19 affected provinces as declared by the Nakhon Ratchasima Communicable Disease Committee. SLRI colleagues are required to provide services based on health safety and risk reduction measures of COVID-19 outbreak and performed in accordance with Announcements of SLRI on Preventive Measures and Surveillances of Coronavirus (2019-nCoV), Commands and Announcements of Nakhon Ratchasima Communicable Disease Committee, Commands and Announcements of Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration, and Commands of the Council of Ministers of Thailand.”

11. Clause 2 stated in the Announcement of Synchrotron Light Research Institute (Public Organization) on Preventive Measures and Surveillances of Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) (No.10) is repealed and the following Clause shall be enforced instead:

“A visit to SLRI by a person or a group of people is permitted under strict SLRI screening processes and measures.”

12. Clause 3 stated in the Announcement of Synchrotron Light Research Institute (Public Organization) on Preventive Measures and Surveillances of Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) (No.10) is repealed and the following Clause shall be enforced instead:

“All activities requiring attendance of SLRI colleagues such as meetings need to be organized under appropriate measures”

13. Clause 5 stated in the Announcement of Synchrotron Light Research Institute (Public Organization) on Preventive Measures and Surveillances of Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) (No.10) is repealed and the following Clause shall be enforced instead:

“ Invitation to participants from overseas to participate SLRI activity, meeting, seminar or other related events need to be organized under the Commands and Announcements of Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration. ”

14. Clause 8 stated in the Announcement of Synchrotron Light Research Institute (Public Organization) on Preventive Measures and Surveillances of Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) (No.10) is repealed and the following Clause shall be enforced instead:

“ SLRI colleagues with at least one following symptom detected i.e. over 37.3°C fever, coughing, runny nose, sore throat, loss of smell, shortness of breath, fatigue or difficulty breathing are required to strictly perform in accordance with Announcements of Nakhon Ratchasima Communicable Disease Committee, Commands and Announcements of Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration, and Commands of the Council of Ministers of Thailand. ”

15. Clause 9 stated in the Announcement of Synchrotron Light Research Institute (Public Organization) on Preventive Measures and Surveillances of Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) (No.10) is repealed.
