Announcement of Synchrotron Light Research Institute (Public Organization) Preventive Measures and Surveillances of Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) (No.19)

Pursuant to the Announcement of Synchrotron Light Research Institute (Public Organization) dated 28 May 2021, on working at residences until 11 June 2021, up to the present time, the situation of Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak is recovering. However, in order to sustain performing under related measures and fend off possible effects on health of SLRI colleagues in overall during returning to work performing at workplace, SLRI needs to implement additional preventive measures.

By virtue of the Decree of Board of SLRI, Ref. No. 7/2020, on "Appointment of Director of Synchrotron Light Research Institute" issued on 29 May 2020, SLRI hereby issues the Announcement of Synchrotron Light Research Institute (Public Organization) on Preventive Measures and Surveillances of Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) (No.19) as follows:

1. The work-from-home measure shall be repealed and SLRI colleagues shall return to work at workplace from 14 June 2021 onwards by strictly complying with preventive measures of COVID-19 outbreak regarding SLRI announcements such as always complete COVID-19 risk assessment form before entering into SLRI area as well as other related regulations, announcements, and orders for risk reduction of COVID-19 outbreak.

2. SLRI colleagues who need to travel for business to maximum control areas which are declared the highest-risk for the spread of COVID-19 by Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration need to strictly comply with orders and announcements of Nakhon Ratchasima Communicable Disease Committee and destination provinces.

3. SLRI services on synchrotron light and laboratory facility application shall be provided as in normal situation with physical presence of only domestic users. In this regard, users coming from maximum control areas as declared by Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration and having plans for overnight stay in Nakhon Ratchasima need to perform as follows:

3.1 inform communicable disease control officers of Suranaree University of Technology Hospital, Debaratana Nakhon Ratchasima Hospital, or other public hospitals within 12 / hours after entering...

3.2 disclose the COVID-19 screen result as stated in Clause 3.1 to SLRI responsible colleagues and always complete the COVID-19 risk assessment form before entering into SLRI area

These measures stated in Article 3 shall be exempted to users who have been fully vaccinated or COVID-19 screened with RT-PCR method for less than 72 hours before entering into Nakhon Ratchasima area and have the screen result disclosed to SLRI responsible colleagues.

4. In case of necessity, organizing of events or activities requiring physical attendance of SLRI colleagues are permitted based on safety measures. SLRI colleagues need to strictly comply with suggestions, orders, and announcements of Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration and Nakhon Ratchasima Communicable Disease Committee concerning cases as follows:

4.1 visits by a person or a group of people from COVID-19 affected areas as declared by Center for COVID-19 Situation Administration to SLRI in Nakhon Ratchasima for business

4.2 invitation to participants from overseas to participate in SLRI activities, meetings, seminars, or other related events

4.3 organizing of events such as conferences requiring physical attendance of SLRI colleagues

5. SLRI canteen service shall be provided as in normal situation. In this regard, non SLRI colleagues need to complete the COVID-19 risk assessment form before entering into the canteen area.

6. For risk reduction of COVID-19 infection, SLRI colleagues need to avoid travelling to places at risk or crowded communities and comply with preventive measures as follows:

6.1 always wear surgical masks and maintain at least 1-2 meters of distance in contacting with other people, and discard all used surgical masks in the provided containers or in closed plastic bags

6.2 always do handwashing with soap and water or 70% alcohol-basedhand sanitizer

6.3 avoid sharing food containers, cutlery, and personal belongings with other people

6.4 in case of having COVID-19 symptoms or suspect of infection, contact a hospital for medical treatment and promptly inform a work superior
